## Polishing Conference in Georgia

The 2009 International Concrete Polishing & Staining Conference (ICPSC) takes place Oct 1-4 at the Gwinnett Center Convention Complex in Duluth, Ga., near Atlanta. CONCRETE SURFACES is the official publication of the conference.
